REGISTRATION NOTICE FOR BTh IN CHRISTIAN MINISTRY (3DG H01 T301P)

- **Please note the following important aspects:**
 - It is a pre-requisite that all Theology students need to have access to a computer and good internet
 - Distance students do not get free data from the NWU
 - Theology students are responsible to buy their own prescribed textbooks
- On the Curriculum Control Form, you will find all the modules of the BTh in Christian Ministry qualification. (*Students associated with AFM have a specific Curriculum Control Form*).
- Note that GRKS172 is a year module in the 1st year and SEMT272 is a year module in the 2nd year while all the other modules are semester specific, meaning the modules are presented either in the 1st semester or during the 2nd semester
- You need to register 1st and 2nd semester modules (also year modules if applicable)
- Minimum time to complete this qualification: 3 years
- Maximum time to complete this qualification: 6 years
- To be finished within the maximum time, you need to register for at least 50% of a year's modules
- The AFM has selected a set curriculum which students who wish to become AFM pastors, must complete. There are thus no electives for this group of students.
- Other BTh in Christian Ministry students must choose between a few groups of electives:
 - 2nd year 1st semester: **select 1** module from DOGM211, KATE213, PAST213
 - 2nd year 2nd semester: **select 1** module from DOGM221, MISS221
 - 3rd year 1st semester: **select 2** modules from KDSG311, MISS311, PAST311
 - 3rd year 2nd semester: **select 2** modules from KDSG321, LITK322, MISS321, PAST321
- Please take note of the pre-requisites that appear in brackets on the Curriculum Control Form. You must first pass the pre-requisite before you can register for the module, e.g. ALDE111 is a pre-requisite for ALDE122
- Please note that the module code of Homiletics (2nd year 2nd sem) changed from HOML221 to HOML222. The content stays the same.
- Before you can register, you first need to pay the minimum amount for registration
 - If you are studying directly with the NWU, the minimum amount payable for 2023 is R11 300.00 (*This amount is a preliminary estimate and is subject to change*).
 - If you are associated with a Learning Support Centre like Cape Town Biblical College, Members in Christ Church (LICKTS) or Apostolic Faith Mission (AFM), the minimum amount payable for 2023 is R5 200.00.
- **DO NOT** try to register if you do not have this amount in your student account. (If you do, it will only be a provisionally registration and will be cancelled after a month if no payment is received.)
- During the online self-registration process, you will be asked to select the Method of Delivery / Presentation Category. Use the drop-down arrow:
 - If you are studying directly with the NWU, click on A DISTANCE (PAY) / Distance
 - If you are associated with Cape Town Biblical College, click on A TEOL CT BIBLICAL C / Distance
 - If you are associated with Heidelberg Theological Seminary, click on A TEOL HTHS / Distance

- If you are associated with Members in Christ Church (LICKTS), click on A TEOL LICKTS / Distance
- If you are associated with the Apostolic Faith Mission, click on A THEOL AGS / Distance
- If you are associated with Dumisani, click on CA.DTI & BS / Distance
- During the online registration process, you will be asked to select a Study Centre. Use the drop-down arrow:
 - If you have chosen A DISTANCE (PAY) / Distance, then your Study Centre is REMOTE
 - If you have chosen A TEOL CT BIBLICAL C / Distance, then your Study Centre is CAPE TOWN BIBLE COLLEGE
 - If you have chosen A TEOL HTHS / Distance, then your Study Centre is HEIDELBERG SEMINARY (THEOLOGY)
 - If you have chosen A TEOL LICKTS / Distance, then your Study Centre is LEDE IN CHRISTUS KERK THEOLOGY UODL
 - If you have chosen A THEOL AGS / Distance, then your Study Centre is THE APOSTOLIC FAITH THEOLOGY
 - If you have chosen CA.DTI & BS, then your Study Centre is DUMISANI (THEOLOGY) Learning Centre
- During the online self-registration process, you will also be asked to select an Exam Centre. Use the drop-down arrow to choose the centre closest to where you stay
